

SELECTMEN'S MEETING MINUTES
Saturday, August 24, 2013 8:30 PM

Members met with Chief O'Leary at the Public Safety Building and proceeded to the Command Center at the Stadium. Chief O'Leary, George Bell and Mike Ashapa of the Stadium Advisory Committee provided a detailed tour of the primary police processing area and the booking and holding area that was specially created for Countryfest. The procedure for protective custodies and arrests was explained including initial booking, transport procedures and processing at the Public Safety Building. Chief O'Leary provided examples of security problems and how they are addressed, and discussed alcohol service times with Selectmen.

Selectmen proceeded through the Stadium with Stadium Advisory Committee members to the medical treatment areas and met with Chief Hatfield for a tour of the facilities. The new medical treatment facility is very spacious and a great improvement for medical staff and emergency transport staff. Chief Hatfield also explained the computer documentation of emergency visits that is used for tracking.

Stadium Advisory Committee members brought the Selectmen to the central Stadium Command Center where Chief O'Leary explained additional security procedures. Selectmen returned to the Public Safety Building and were given a tour of the special holding areas by the Sergeant in charge.

Meeting adjourned at 10:15 PM.
