

TOWN CLERK'S REPORT
ANNUAL TOWN ELECTION

Monday, May 4, 2009

In accordance with posted Warrants for Town Elections, the inhabitants of the Town of Foxborough, qualified to vote in elections met in the John J. Ahern Middle School, 111 Mechanic Street, in Precincts No. 1, No. 2, No. 3, No. 4, and No. 5.

The polls opened at 7:00 A.M. with Warden Kathleen M. Brady in charge of all precincts.

At 8:00 P.M., the polls were closed, and the ballots were sorted and counted. The number of ballots

agreed with the checklist, and it was announced that the number of votes cast was 2,606. Three hundred seventy-six (376) registered voters voted in Precinct No. 1; five hundred fifteen (515) in Precinct No. 2; five hundred forty-six (546) in Precinct No. 3; five hundred ninety-seven (597) in Precinct No. 4; and five hundred seventy-two (572) in Precinct No. 5. The percentage of registered voters who voted was 24.7%. At the time of the election, there were ten thousand five hundred seventy-two (10,572) inhabitants registered to vote.
