



TOWN CLERK'S REPORT
STATE PRIMARY ELECTION

Tuesday, the 14th Day of September, 2010

In accordance with posted Warrants for a State Primary, the inhabitants of the Town of Foxborough, qualified to vote in elections, met in the gymnasium of the John J. Ahern Middle School, 111 Mechanic Street, in Precincts No. 1, 2, 3, 4, and 5.

The polls opened at 7:00 A.M. with Warden Kathleen M. Brady in charge of all precincts. At 8:00 P.M., the polls were closed, and the ballots were sorted and counted. The number of ballots agreed with the checklists. Of the one thousand five hundred ninety-one (1,591) registered voters who cast ballots, eight hundred thirty-four (834) voted on Democratic

Ballots and seven hundred fifty-seven (757) voted on Republican Ballots. No voters chose to vote on the Libertarian Ballot.

There were two hundred sixty-nine (269) ballots cast in Precinct #1; three hundred fifty-two (352) in Precinct #2; three hundred eleven (311) in Precinct #3; three hundred thirty-two (332) in Precinct #4; and three hundred twenty-seven (327) in Precinct #5. This was 15% of the ten thousand six hundred sixteen (10,616) inhabitants who were registered to vote at the time of the primary.
