Minutes of July 15, 2009

1. Minutes of last Meeting of May 27, 2009 were accepted.
2. Bill Casbarra presented the Committee with a draft of a letter that will be sent to Selectmen expressing our concern in regards to the removal of detectable warning surfaces at sidewalk curb cuts in the center of Town. We all accepted the wording of the letter. Sue Collins, as Chairperson, will come in and sign the letter which then be forwarded to Paul Feeney, Chairman of Selectmen.
3. Chuck Gallagher spoke about his ideas to improve Handicapped Parking spots. Blue paint on the ground and uniform blue signage and increasing the fine to \$100 was discussed. We could propose a new By-Law for a Town Meeting. It was decided to wait until the next meeting when we hope to invite Jeffrey Dougan and Jackie Higgins from the Massachusetts Office on Disability.
4. Excess of Stadium Parking in some areas when there are no full events going on in Gillette Stadium was discussed. Custom bags will cover certain Handicapped Parking signs when there are no large stadium events (less than 50,000 tickets). During Full stadium events, the bags would be removed.
