The Foxborough DPW is seeking applicants for a full-time Equipment Operator in the Highway Dept., to perform skilled work in the operation of power equipment and motor equipment necessary for the construction, repair, cleaning and maintenance of roads, facilities, sewers, and drainage systems and related grounds. This is a full time (40 hour/week) benefit eligible position reporting to the Director of Public Works

*Duties include but are not limited to:* Operates various vehicles and equipment such as, but not limited to trucks, tractors, street sweepers, small rollers, compactors, motor vehicles, chain saws, mowers, power saws, brush cutters, leaf blowers and collectors, paint machines, compressors, etc. Maintains grounds along public ways including trees, laws, center strips, traffic islands, drainage structures and appurtenances, retention walls, curbing, berm, etc. Maintains roads, streets, sidewalks and parking areas using asphalt, bituminous material and cement concrete to do surfacing, resurfacing, construction, and patching. Loads and unloads trucks. Digs holes and trenches. Picks up trash on Town property. Collects and disposes of leaves. Mows and trims grass, shrubs, trees, etc. Participates in all snow and ice control activities. Performs all other related duties as required.

*Qualifications and experience:* Must be at least eighteen (18) years old with a high school diploma and three (3) years of job related experience. Must be able to qualify for a valid CDL with all applicable endorsements within 6 months of employment and a Class B Hoisting Engineer's License from the Department of Public Safety for the appropriate equipment within one year of employment.
