**Master Plan – Guiding Foxborough’s Future: Goals and Priorities Forum**

Mr. Grieder introduced the meeting and summarized the Master Plan work that has been done so far. He stated that the Master Plan is meant to be a working document.

Kathy McCabe of McCabe Enterprises, John Shevlin and Tim Thies of PARE Corporation comprised the consultant team who will be leading the discussion this evening. The team gave a Power Point presentation explaining the Master Plan, its purpose and benefits to the town. They expect to have the Master Plan draft ready in May and have a Public Hearing in June.

Ms. McCabe noted that in 1955 there were 8,500 residents in town, in 2015 there are 16,000 living here and in 2035 it is projected that 18,000 will be living here.

Mr. Shevlin addressed the Transportation aspect including the goals and recommendations.

Mr. Thies reviewed the Community Facilities aspect including water, sewer, electricity, dams and municipal buildings.

Other topics that were reviewed included Agriculture, Natural and Cultural Resources, Recreation and Open Space, Land Use and Economic Development; the areas of town that were addressed were the downtown and Route 1.

A poll of the attendees was taken on the priorities of various issues and recommendations in town. The team then reviewed the results of the poll with the participants.

Other discussions revolved around sewers, schools and 40B applications.

The meeting was adjourned at 9:00 p.m.
