Limit 5 Gallons or 45 lbs (amounts in excess are subject to a charge)

Empty aerosol cans go in regular trash.



\*BATTERIES: Alkaline batteries (AA,AAA,C,D,3/6/9/12 volt) can be discarded in regular trash.

Rechargeable batteries (nickel Cadmium, Lithium Ion, Nickel) are found in cell phones, cameras, clocks, hearing aids, & power tools.

Rechargeable batteries can also be dropped in special battery boxes at the Library and Town Hall.

## **NOT ACCEPTED:**

Latex paint\*\* (see below)

Explosive Materials: Ammunition, Fireworks, & Explosives

Propane Tanks

Smoke Detectors

Fire Extinguishers

Gas Cylinders

Prescription Medicines & Syringes

Medical Waste

Commercial / Industrial Waste

Asbestos & Asbestos Products

## **NEVER MIX CHEMICALS**

\* Use original container, tighten caps and lids.

\* Sort and pack separately: oil paint, pesticides and household cleaners.

\* Pack in sturdy upright containers and pad with newspaper.

\* Do not place in garbage bags.

\* Never smoke while handling hazardous material.

\*\*LATEX PAINT is non-hazardous. Please solidify and put in trash. Containers more than half full can be brought to the Paint Collection Center at the Highway Dept. on Mondays 7:30AM - 3:45PM (holidays excluded)

## **REMINDER**

Motor Oil May be brought to the Highway Garage Mon - Friday, 7:30AM - 3:45PM.

Oil based paints/  
thinners/stains May be brought to the Highway Garage Monday only (excluding holidays), 7:30AM - 3:45PM.

Mercury Items All mercury bearing items (fluorescent bulbs, thermometers, etc.) may be brought to the Highway Garage Monday only (excluding holidays), 7:30AM - 3:45PM.
