

**Minutes
Of
The Foxboro Water and Sewer Commissioners
April 29, 2013**

Members in Attendance: Chairman Bill Euerle Vice Chairman M. Stanton, Water Superintendant B. Worthley, DPW Director R. Hill, Town Engineer B. Swanson, B. Garber, Planning Board members B. Grieder and G. Greene, Board of Selectmen G. Coppola, Town Manager K. Paicos

The meeting was called to order at 7:00 p.m.

Ralph and Edna Hunt came to a recent meeting to ask for abatement for their high water bill. They are elderly and went away for part of the winter and are not sure why it was so high.

A motion to abate the bill for Ralph and Edna Hunt of 206 East Street to the last highest quarterly reading was approved 2-0.

Mr. Paicos noted that he feels it was a good decision by the Board to assist Foxboro's elderly. Mr. Greene volunteered to help them out next year when they go away for the winter.

A Sewer Permit has been received for 63 Morse Street, this was previously approved last summer and they are now applying for the permit.

Mr. Paicos stated that he has met with Cannon Forge to negotiate reselling their surplus sewer capacity to the town. Mr. Hill has also been speaking to them. They have a preliminary agreement in place that will enable the town to buy the capacity at \$5.07 per gallon and take over their sewer lines to the Sharon town line. The town will be able to buy the capacity in any amount up to and including all available capacity when it is needed. An I/I study will be needed to help determine the final surplus number; it is estimated to be about 40,000 gallons. The sale of this capacity will help fund the regional plant.

Special Town Counsel wrote up the agreement, the Board of Cannon Forge will be meeting to discuss the proposal this week and then the general membership will need to vote on it. A letter agreeing to negotiate with them needs to be signed by the Board. A motion to sign the letter was approved 2-0.

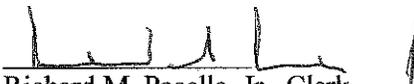
This will be Mr. Euerle's last meeting as he is not running for re-election. The Board thanked Bill for all his work on the Board these past three years.
