**Re: Discount currently available to Eligible Foxboro Senior Citizens Correction Notice**  
PLEASE DISREGARD OCTOBER 27, 2009 NOTICE

Dear Board Members:

***The purpose of this letter is to detail the senior citizen discount that is currently provided by Comcast (the "Company") to qualified Foxborough cable service subscribers and to eliminate any confusion around this issue***

Senior Citizen Discount

The period for the senior citizen discount will be concurrent with the recently executed cable television renewal license. Comcast reserves the right to modify or eliminate such program at its sole discretion.

Although the company offers levels of Service that it feels is affordable, we are pleased to be able to provide a senior citizen discount to qualified Foxborough senior citizens. To that end, the Company will voluntarily continue to offer a discount equal to two (2) dollars off its monthly Standard Service rate or that Digital Level of Service which most closely resembles the Standard Service ( defined as that service in place for existing Standard Service subscribers) as of the date of execution of the Renewal License. Said discount is currently provided to those persons age sixty-five (65) or older, who are head of household and are receiving SSI or Medicaid benefits under Social Security. A qualifying subscriber must be able to show proof of such qualifications. Acceptable documentation would be the following:

- Proof of Age – Drivers License, Birth Certificate, or Passport
- Head of Household – Lease, Deed, City Tax Bill
- Receiving SSI or Medicaid benefits under Social Security

In the event Comcast adopts and offers a statewide senior citizen discount program, Comcast reserves the right to implement such program, after reasonable notice to your office.
