2013 ROAD REPAVING PROGRAM

START @ 7:00 AM TUESDAY NOVEMBER 5, 2013

Beginning Tuesday November 5, 2013 at 7:00 AM, we will be proceeding further with our street repaving program. This year we will be repaving 14 streets with a Pavement Overlay. This consists of applying hot asphalt mix and rolling it with two large compaction rollers. The hot asphalt will be delivered by approximately 10 trucks. It is almost impossible to schedule this amount of work precisely. There may be changes due to weather, equipment breakdowns, & delays at the asphalt plant. **We will place signs in your neighborhood the day before paving that read "ROAD WORK TOMORROW" & "PARKING BAN IN EFFECT".**

Order of Paving:

Day 1: Harnden Road, Kersey Road, Neponset Heights Ave., Creighton Ave., Creighton Lane, Idlewild Street, & the very end of Ridge Road (the "T"), Park Ave., Comey Ave., & Oak Hill Ave.

- East Belcher Road & Summer Place
- Morse Street (south of Morse Place)
- Mill Street & Prospect Street

School Buses, Trash Trucks, Police & Fire Vehicles will have access through the work zone at all times. **!!PLEASE NOTE!!** In an emergency the Police or Fire vehicles will go directly to your house with no delay. However, it is possible that the School Department may contact you in advance and revise a pickup or drop-off location. There will be times when your road is closed to motorists. Motorists should avoid the work area. Access to or from your driveway will not be possible for approximately 1 hour or more when we are working directly in front of your house. The road will be opened to traffic at the end of the day after the day's work is finished. The normal work day will be from 7:00 AM to 4:00 PM.

You may wish to park your vehicles outside the work zone if you need to leave during the projected time period. You should assume that you will not have access to your house at noontime. Please avoid the work area to allow for an excellent final product with no tire marks.

Foxborough Police and Highway Department personnel will be on-site to assist you should you wish to enter or exit your residence.

Please plan your driving to avoid traffic delays.

SUMMER PLACE RESIDENTS: Your street is narrow, so that it must be paved curb to curb in one, single pass. There will not be any exit or entrance for residents during paving for approximately 3 hours. Please plan accordingly. Police and Fire will get to your house in an emergency during this shut-down period.

We are also seeking your help to please keep your children away from the work site during the normal work day.

Please note: This schedule is dependent on weather and equipment breakdowns, & is subject to change.
