

Time being 7:00 p.m. **October 16, 2017** Eric Arvedon opened the meeting of the Foxborough Board of Health, under the Open Meeting Laws of the State of Massachusetts. Eric Arvedon, Chairman presiding, Paul Mullins, Vice-Chairman, Paul Steeves, Clerk, and Pauline Zajdel, Health Director were present. Meeting took place in the Public Safety Building, McGinty Room at 8 Chestnut Street. Minutes were taken by Pauline Zajdel.

7:00 p.m. Public Hearing: To discuss and/or vote on the Draft Municipal Hauler Regulation, Industrial Wastewater Transporting, application and fee.

(No interested parties in attendance for this public hearing)

Paul Steeves read the public hearing notice that was published in the Foxboro Reporter on October 5, 2017 and October 12, 2017. The purpose of the hearing was to discuss the Board of Health's regulatory authority as it relates to the permitting of industrial wastewater haulers who are collecting and transporting industrial wastewater from Foxborough businesses and establishments. Haulers licensed by the Board of Health would be required to adhere to all requirements that fall under 314 CMR 18.12.

Paul Steeves made a motion to adopt the Industrial Wastewater Transporters Application effective January 1, 2018 and adding the one hundred dollar (\$100) application fee to the existing fee schedule. Paul Mullins seconded the motion. All in favor, 3-0.

John Glossa explained to the Board that initial installation of the leaching chambers, performed by Mike Pacella Excavating, resulted in two chambers across neighbor's property line (5 Michelle's Way). Upon knowledge of the encroachment, John Glossa immediately notified Mr. Murphy and Mike Pacella. John Glossa suggested taking the chambers that were on the 5 Michelle's Way property and relocate them.

Paul Prevett of 5 Michelle's Way stated this variance does not impact his property and that he supports the variance.

John Glossa stated he was never asked to stake out the property. He added that Mike Pacella was very proactive in responding to and correcting the problem.
