The work is progressing well. It is a little behind schedule. Target date for completion is July 2020.

Update on Well Rehabilitation

Well #16 is on-line and producing 350 gallons per minute. Well #13 will be off-line either October 7th or 14th, 2019 until the new treatment plant is on-line. Wells #10, #9 and #14 are the next in line for maintenance. Wells #10 and #9 will be done in the next three months.

We are putting a new main in on Ledgeville Avenue. The price to replace the 6" with the 8" was the same as it would have been to re-line it. This should be done by September 23, 2019.

Beach Street is done and paved.

There is a new main at Forbes and Foxborough Boulevards.

Tank Rehab

The rehab went well; there were no water pressure problems and no complaints.

Rules and Regulations

This has been tabled until the next meeting.

Consulting Contract for Witch Pond Monitoring

The Board will not sign up at this time until further discussion.
