Open Meeting Minutes

November 10, 2020

Members in Attendance: Mike Stanton, Chairman; Richard Pacella, Vice-Chairman; and Robert Garber, Secretary

The meeting was called to order at 7:00 p.m. by Chairman Stanton.

Project Updates

The Oak Street well bid has been received. We are currently working on the contract documents.

Permitting continues for the replacement well for Witch Pond Well #14.

Work is continuing with DEP on permitting the Raw Water Line from Sprague Road to Witch Pond.

The design for the West Street water main project is in the final stages; we are waiting on permitting for the dam. This will be out to bid this winter.

Update on Station One Treatment Plant

The Station One Treatment Plant is substantially complete and went into operation October 1, 2020. Work is being done on punch list items. The plant will be staffed while in operation, per DEP's requirement, for 90 days. After 90 days, we will apply for an approval to operate remotely.

Update on Water Restrictions

The statewide drought conditions still exist, although conditions are improving.

Action Items

- Superintendent's Report

The new plant is a welcomed addition to the system. The Department is working with the contractor to complete the punch list items, and any additional items that the staff might have noticed, now that it is operational. The office staff is continuing with the upgrade of Munis. The staff is preparing to read all meters in the system the first week of January.


- 81 Fairway Lane

An abatement request from Eric Arvedon of 81 Fairway Lane was filed with the office. Usage was high, and therefore resulted in a higher than normal quarterly bill. The meter was changed and is being sent for testing.

A motion was made by Richard Pacella to approve the abatement request for 81 Fairway Lane. The motion was seconded by Robert Garber. The motion was denied - zero in favor; three against.

Upon a motion duly made by Robert Garber and seconded by Michael Stanton, it was voted to adjourn at 7:40 p.m.
