Bill Keegan - 6 Items of agenda, 4 appearing on January STM.

1:42 min A Presentation Tony Moussalli - Laundry Building
Requesting additional 200K for demolition. Originally authorized for 150k, but after bid price is 295K. Architect is approximately 56K bringing project to 350K.
Bill Keegan - possible site for community center current building costs prohibitive.

6:04 min B Presentation Mike Grace - Taser
Police reform bill requires all officers to have the same training and equipment. Foxborough has a large reserve force for stadium requiring an additional 30 tasers bringing the total to 70. Older taser models will not be covered by insurance, requiring a total purchase every 5 years. Quoted price is good till the end of the annual year, requiring placement on STM. Total cost is 250K, 50K per year for 5 years.
John Mahoney - Do we receive equipment in installments?
Mike Grace - All equipment up front, payments on installment.
Bill Keegan - STM has 50K, but committee is committing for 5 years.

16:14 min C Presentation Mike Kelleher - Staff Vehicle, Garage Doors
In collaboration with police dept., fire dept. has hired an emergency social worker to show up on scene. Social worker paid from public health revolving. A small 4 wheel drive SUV is needed for transportation. Supplemental appropriation.
Chris Gallagher - Hard to price vehicles due to supply chain issues.
Additional \$9,200.00 required.

Garage doors are original to building. In the past 5 years problems becoming worse. Door stop in up position and sometimes down. Major problem during emergency runs. Would like to repair 5 front doors as well as back doors. Ambulance has been parked in reverse to deal with current situation.
