To either of the Constables of the Town of Foxborough:

Greetings:

In the name of the Commonwealth of Massachusetts and in accordance with the provisions of the By-Laws of said Town, and Amendments thereof, you are hereby required to notify and warn the inhabitants of the Town of Foxborough, qualified to vote at elections and town affairs to assemble in the auditorium of Foxborough High School on South Street at 7:00 o'clock in the afternoon on Monday, the sixteenth day of October A.D., 2023 to act on the following articles:

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ARTICLE 1:

(DPW Building Repair and Maintenance Project)

To see if the Town will vote to borrow, transfer from available funds, or raise and appropriate, funds to pay for repairs and upgrades, including roofing, masonry repairs, doors, windows, exterior and interior painting, upgrades to HVAC system, and electrical service repairs to the DPW Main Garage located at 70 Elm Street in Foxborough, MA (Map 107 Parcel 036 and consists of 9.75 Acres). Said repair and maintenance work to be completed under the direction of the Town’s Facilities Department and DPW Administration; or take any other action related thereto.

ARTICLE 2:

(Revolving Fund By-Law Amendment)

To see if the Town will vote to amend Chapter 20, Section 33 (Authorize Revolving Funds) of the Town of Foxborough By-Laws relative to the Council on Aging Senior Trips and Programs to read as follows:

ARTICLE 3:

(Personal Property Exemption Threshold Amendment)

To see if the Town will vote pursuant to G.L. Chapter 59, Section 5, Clause 54 to increase the personal property taxation exemption from a fair cash value of Seven Hundred and Fifty Dollars (\$750.00) to Five Thousand Dollars (\$5,000.00) effective Fiscal Year 2025, commencing on July 1, 2024; or take any other action related thereto.

ARTICLE 4:

(Acceptance of Souza Avenue as a Public Way)

To see if the Town will accept as a public way Souza Avenue, which has been constructed pursuant to the Planning Board Subdivision Control Regulations as follows; or to take any other action related thereto:

Souza Avenue – from its intersection with East Belcher Road generally northeasterly approximately 700 feet more or less to its intersection with Barros Lane.

ARTICLE 5:

(Acceptance of Barros Lane as a Public Way)

To see if the Town will accept as a public way Barros Lane, which has been constructed pursuant to the Planning Board Subdivision Control Regulations as follows; or to take any other action related thereto:

Barros Lane – from its intersection with Souza Avenue generally northwesterly approximately 800 feet more or less to its terminus at East Belcher Road.


Hereof, fail not, and make due return of this warrant with your doings to the Town Clerk, at the time and place of said meeting.
