HUNTING RULES

FOXBOROUGH CONSERVATION LAND

Hunting is *only* allowed on Conservation Commission-approved (Town-owned) conservation land, with the following conditions:

A. BEFORE YOU HUNT ON TOWN-OWNED CONSERVATION LAND

Every year that you plan to hunt in a town-owned conservation area, please visit the Conservation Office on the 2nd floor of Town Hall first, to:

1. **Submit** your name, address, and current hunting license number and date;
2. **Pick up** our detailed hunting maps, which have been created to help our hunters to navigate (maps are aerials photos with conservation boundaries and State-allowed hunting perimeters [*detailed in C, below*]); and
3. **Review** hunting maps and discuss any questions or concerns you might have with our conservation staff; *we're here to assist you!*

Please Note: Many (*but not all*) of our conservation areas have Foxborough Conservation Land signs, so if you're planning to hunt in an area that doesn't have one of our signs, you could be illegally entering private property.

B. NO HUNTING IS ALLOWED IN THE FOLLOWING AREAS (*alphabetical order*)

1. Cannon Forge Subdivision Open Space (*off Cocasset Street*)
2. Cocasset River Preserve
3. Hersey Farm (*Rt. 140*)
4. Lane Property (*off North Street*)
5. Neponset Reservoir
6. Oak Street, East (*the old Lincoln Hill Camp*)
7. Turner Property (*off Cedar Street*)
8. Walden Farms (*Mechanic Street*)

C. WITHOUT EXCEPTION (*as all hunters know*), the discharge of any firearm or the release of an arrow from any bow is prohibited:

1. Within 500 feet of any dwelling;
2. Within 150 feet of a hard surfaced roadway; or
3. Within 100 feet of a conservation trail.
